Late Model Ducati Cylinder Head Nut Torque Tool



## General Usage Notes and Suggestions

- [1] If you don't already have one, get a copy of the OEM, Haynes or DesmoTimes service manual for your bike. For general maintenance, the Haynes and the DesmoTimes manuals are excellent.
- [2] Always use the cylinder head nut torque instructions found in the service manuals.
- [3] Do follow the torque sequence; the head gasket will have a much better chance of sealing properly.
- [4] Always use this tool in such a manner that the torque tool is at right angles to the torque wrench—this preserves the proper torque value. See images below for example usage.
- [5] Occasionally, the castings variations of Ducati cylinder heads are such that it might be a tight fit between the tool, the head casting and the 15 mm head nut. If this is the case, it is permissible to grind away a small amount of the edge of the tool to enable an easier fit.
